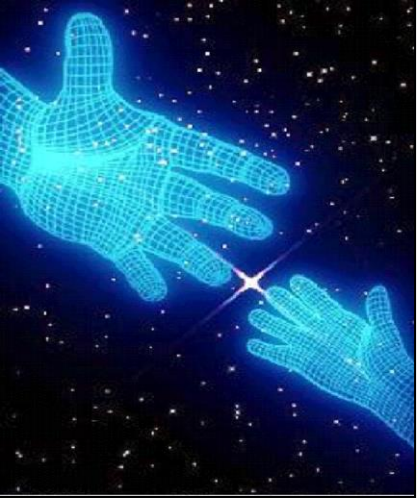




Tell me something I don't know.

What's in it for me?



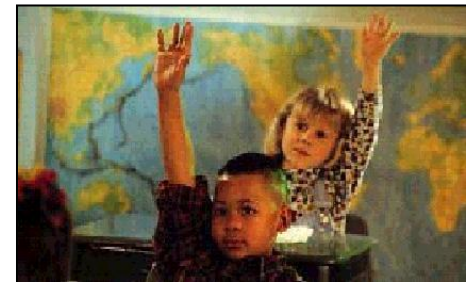
- Participating Students receive scholarships from product success not to exceed \$120,000.00 paid in annual increments of \$30,000.00
